Frequently Asked Questions

How much will I earn as an apprentice on the Complete Instructor Academy?

You will earn a full time apprentice wage while contracted with us for your 12 months. This is equivalent to approximately £707 a month. You will also be entitled to 26 paid holiday days per year.

Will I need a car?

A car is not necessary as all training will be done at South Cerney Outdoor, which has good public transport and cycle network links.

Can I borrow boats etc at the weekend?

Subject to availability, all SCO staff can access all our equipment outside of your work time and subject to it not being used by groups. You may also take some equipment off site if it is not required for on site activities. Speak to the Operations Manager to find out more.

How many hours per week will I be working?

You will be contracted to 36 hours per week of paid work with us. The first 5-6 month will be focused on your personal training and achievement of the necessary industry qualifications. The training process is generally a 9-5 Monday to Friday week. This is followed, by six months work experience in our peak season, where working hours will include evenings and weekends on a shift basis.

What happens if I get injured or ill?

You are a member of our staff team as an apprentice and will be covered by the same rights and benefits that full time staff receive. This includes annual leave entitlement and sick pay once you are past your probationary period. Your contract will explain all the details.

How easy is it to get a job at the end of the course?





As a CIA graduate you will be qualified to apply for most instructor positions in water-based outdoor centres in the UK and overseas. At South Cerney Outdoor, we recruit for up to 10 full time seasonal contracted positions plus casual staff between April and September each year and we have local partners who are keen to talk to our graduates for summer positions. As part of your programme, we will also assist you with making contacts and submitting applications to National and International operators.

I'm a complete beginner, will I be able to keep up?

The CIA apprenticeship programme is designed to take you from no experience to qualified and experienced instructor over your 12 month contract.

How fit do I need to be?

A good basic level of fitness is recommended. Water sports can be physically demanding and although your strength and fitness will develop during the apprenticeship, it is ideal to work on your base fitness before attending so that it does not hold you back.

Do I need to buy any kit before I start?

We will provide you with all the core kit you need while on the training part of your apprenticeship however, quality personal kit can be invaluable and will serve you into your career in the industry. We would generally not recommend rushing out to buy your own kit, unless you have friends in the industry who can advise you. Before and when you start the programme, our instructors will advise you on the pros and cons of all kit selections and help you make an informed choice. We can also source kit recommended by our senior instructors from some of our trade discount sources.
